

RECORD OF THE EMERGENCE OF ADULTS OF THE COCKSFOOT STEM BORER IN 1961

As little information on the biology of the Cocksfoot Stem Borer in New Zealand has been published, the following record of the emergence of adults is given.

On the 18th August, 1961, a collection of cocksfoot stems was made from a roadside at Lincoln College, to obtain adults of *Glyphipteryx achlyoessa* (Meyr.).

Approximately 300 stems were collected and the emergence of adults was as follows:

In addition 2 further adults emerged during September but their emergence dates were not accurately known. Thus in all, 26 adults emerged from approximately 300 stems.
